Application Questions

1. Give God Your Best – “No Reserves” Don't hold back – Give God the good and the bad and watch him multiply it.

Describe what you think Bill Borden meant by “No Reserves.”

(Philippians 3:12-14) Are you holding anything back from God? What? Why? Make a plan today to give that area of your life to God. Tell someone.

For our students: Is there someone following Jesus on your campus that you wish you were more like? How can you show the love of Christ on your campus?

2. Give God your challenges – “No Retreats” Don't allow the failures and challenges of the past to dictate or color how you serve God today.

(2 Corinthians 12:7-9) Make a list of areas in your life that are hindering your relationship with God.

What practical steps will you take this week to deal with these areas?

3. Give God Thanks – “No Regrets” Give up on trying to be someone else – you are who you are by the grace of God.

(1 Cor 15:9-11) Do you dwell on who you were before you got saved? How can focusing on God's grace help you put your life before salvation behind you?

Make a list of your talents. Ask God to show you how best they can be used to extend his kingdom.
